### There are two types of permits.

- 1. Ramapo Alcohol Permit (Internal)
- 2. ABC Permit: Special Permit for Social Affairs (External)



### When do I need a Ramapo Alcohol permit?

Whenever you are serving alcohol on campus and there is NO money changing hands at or before the event.

### When do I need an ABC permit?

When there is a cash bar or money is changing hands?

### What if the alcohol is free but participants pay an admission fee?

That would still be considered an exchange of money and require an ABC permit.

## What if the tickets are prepaid and no money is given at the door?

That would still be considered an exchange of money and require an ABC permit.
