

**Memorandum of Agreement
Between Ramapo College of New Jersey, The Council of New Jersey State Colleges,
Locality AFT AFL CIO and the Ramapo Federation of Teachers, Local 2274**

Student Opinion Surveys - Spring 2020

In order to promote amicable employer-employee relations, Ramapo College of New Jersey ("Merchant PRS Ramapo College"), The Council of New Jersey State Colleges ("CNSC") and the Ramapo Federation of Teachers, Local 2274 (hereinafter "the Union"), hereby agree to the following:

1. It is agreed that as a result of COVID-19, teaching faculty shall not be required to teach all full-time and adjunct faculty will not be required to teach part-time.
2. It is also agreed that as a result of the pandemic, there will be no compensation for non-teaching staff.
3. The parties agree that this Memorandum of Agreement shall not constitute a precedent and shall not be cited in any grievance except to one or more of the parties. In addition, this Memorandum of Agreement is not intended to supersede any agreement negotiated either individually or in the collective bargaining process.
