Deputy (G) for Intelligence, 2d Infantry Division, Republic of Korea; Division G Leader, Intercept Platoon Leader, 2d Battalion, 1st Infantry Division, Signal Intelligence Officer, Company Commander, 1st Military Intelligence Brigade, Fort Meade, Maryland; Corps Battalion S-3, 1st Military Intelligence Battalion and Brigade Deputy Commander, 1st Military Intelligence Brigade, Baden-Baden, Germany; Joint Staff Planner and Executive Assistant to the Joint Staff J-2; Commander, Battalion, Bay Air Force Base, Germany; Command Allied Command Counterintelligence, Supreme Headquarters, North Atlantic Treaty Organization, then served as the Deputy Commander, U.S. Army Europe and the J-2, U.S. European Command, Stuttgart; assignment as the Commanding General of the United States Army Europe and Fort Huachuca. She assumed duties as the Deputy Commander of the United States Army on September 1, 2000.

Her deployments include United Nations Military Advisor in Africa, 1st Military Intelligence Battalion S-3, then Deputy Commander, 1st Military Intelligence Brigade, Operation Iraqi Freedom, Commander, Theater Intelligence Combined Joint Task Force Operation Enduring Freedom, Afghanistan.
