





- 4 month and 5 month payment plans per semester for full or partial balances
- Register through Student Accounts after registration
- \$60-\$801 time fee, persenester

NATIONAL LEVEL

- 2024-2025 FAFSA Simplification is here
- 2024-2025 FAFSA is delayed, but should be available by December 31. Deadline to complete the form for Freshmen is still. June 1st
- EFC-Estimated Family Contribution is now called SAI-Student Aid Index
- Federal Covernment hopes the changes will expand Pell eligibility to more families
- SA can be a negative number
- Applicants must include the value of businesses and farms
- While the FAFSA will still ask for the number in the household in college it is not included in the pell formula
- Household size should correspond with the dependents that are daimed on the Federal Tax return



- Push to REQUIREMENT to use IRS Direct Data Exchange with ED similar to transferring data from the IRS as in the past but consent is now mandatory to receive aid
- Student has to invite parent/contributor to fill out FAFSA form
- Parents can still get an FSAID even if they do not have a social security number

RAMAPO LEVEL

- Admissions Application deadline for Marit Scholarship review is December 15th, FAFSA is not required
- Scholarship amounts range from \$1,000 to \$14,000
- College Financing Plans will go out by mid-February for Early Decision and Early Action students (Provided the FAFSA is not delayed)
- · Early Decision deposit dead line is February 1st
- Regular decision students still on track for March 2024 College Financing Plan release
- Still on track for May 1st deposit deadline
- Rofessional judgement review is still available for income changes

RAMAPO LEVEL

· Professional judgement review

- vill be considered for household size (need to provide proof the family is paying 50% or more of the persons living expense for individuals not daimed on federal tax return)
- isstill available for income changes
- 30% of students still expected to be selected for verification. The hope is students be required to turn in fever documents.
- Ramapo College Grant monies based on need




What is the Educational Opportunity Fund (EOF) State Program?

EOF Qualifications & Eligibility

- 1. Demonstrate financial background that reflects historical poverty
- 2 Limited academic resources and support.
- ³ Be a NewJersey resident for 12 consecutive months
- 4 Must flie a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the NJ Alternative Financial Aid Application
- 5 Meet ROV ECF Admissions criteria
 - a Submit academic and financial documents (2 years of tax documents & Asset Form)
 - ^b 25/40CPA minimum | Average 30/40
 - c Classrank Top half of their class (if reported)

NJ Gear Up/Callege Bound Program & NJ TRO (Upvard Bound) students qualify for EOF regardless of financial background. Can participate in EOF Summer Program and receive support funding during the academic year.

EOF 5-Week Summer Studies Institute

- Take up to four college credits
- Supplemental Instruction Program
- Success Seminar taught by ECF Advisor
- Paired with a Peer Success Mentor
- Redaim My Math Workshops
- Consulting with Center for Reading & Writing




Nationally, <u>33%</u> of undergraduates identify as fist-generation


